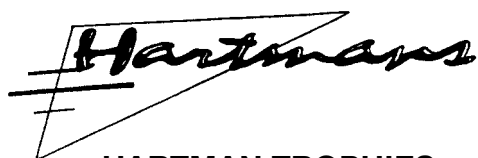

ON-LINE REGISTRATION: for your convenience, you can now register your player(s) on our website and pay all fees on-line as well. On-line registrations must still be completed by March 20th to avoid late fees, and on-line payment does include a \$5 handling fee. GIRLS' GREEN & RED HAT DRAFTS: in an effort to better balance teams, **skill assessments will be used for coaches to draft teams** as is done in the respective Boys' leagues. Also, "play with a friend" requests cannot be honored in these leagues under this process.

Equipment/ Awards	Jersey, Hat/Visor & participation award for all players. League supplies bats & balls.
Teams	Separate boys' and girls' leagues, organized by neighborhood.
