NEW IN 2018

ON-LINE REGISTRATION: Successfully launched in 2017, we will continue moving towards this process as our primary registration method. This process saves countless volunteer hours while providing convenience for our families. Beginning this spring, we will no longer accept registrations by mail. Registrations can be submitted either through our on-line application or at one of our three (3) walk-in sessions (see p. 3).

RED HAT BASEBALL: To provide a smoother transition from our 11-12 to 13-14 year old league, we will begin playing on a slightly larger field this spring. Baselines will move from 60 to 70 feet, while pitching distance will increase from 46 to 50 feet. This will help our players move to 80’/54’ dimensions in Blue Hat Baseball.

LINDSAY’S LAW: In an effort to reduce the occurrence of sudden cardiac arrest in youth athletics, legislation passed last year institutes new league, parent and player requirements. Parents and players **must** view a video from the Ohio Department of Health and sign/return a form to the league reflecting such. We will be incorporating this into our on-line registration application. Please see additional info on p. 11.
