
Huber Village "Memory Wall"

We expect all players, coaches and fans to respect the work of our umpires. Understand that our younger and less experienced umpires officiate in the Green and Red Hat leagues and may make mistakes while learning.

We need everyone's help to make sure that the WYBSL experience is a great one for all players. Please direct your "enthusiasm" toward positive encouragement.

If you observe negative conduct, excessive "intensity" or willful violations of the rules on the part of anyone – speak to your coach or, if appropriate, call your Program Director or the WYBSL answering service (614) 523-6101 immediately. The league will review the basis of your concern in a confidential manner and, if warranted, deal with such conduct fairly, but swiftly.
